What can we say about God?

Genesis 2:8-9, Genesis 2:15-17

This verse gives us three concepts.

- The LORD God took the man and put him into the garden of Eden to cultivate it and keep it.
- God commanded the man, saying, "From any tree of the garden you may eat freely."
- From the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat from it you will surely die.

GOD BEING GOD:

- Determines standards of conduct for mankind—*Ex. 20:1-17*
- Demands absolute obedience to those standards—*Gen. 22:1-12*
- Judges the lives, actions, and attitudes of man—*Gen. 18:25; Acts 17:31*
- Takes vengeance—*Ps. 94:1; Rom. 12:17-19*
- Controls all of life—*Job 12:13-25; Acts 17:24-28a*
- Exercises sovereign independence,
doing whatever He pleases—*Ps. 135:5-6; Dan. 4:35*
- Seeks the praise, worship, and
acceptance of mankind—*Isa. 42:8; John 4:23*
- Asks help and guidance from no one—*Isa. 40:13-14; Rom. 11:33-34*
