Genesis 15:1
Why would Abram be?
1. God - God's plan from the beginning has been to make Himself known to all people.
2. Bible people - The bravest and most faithful men are afraid of God.
3. Our lives - When we fear what lies ahead remember that God will stay with us through difficult times and has promised us great blessings!
Genesis 15:1
Has God to take us out of the battle or to rescue us and others from conflict?
1. God - He is the faith and the giver of faith we need.
2. Bible people - Abram's faith pleased God.
3. Our lives - We can be strong and win the daily battles with faith and trust in God and His provision.
<b>Genesis 15:2-5</b>
God promised like the stars in the sky or the grains of sand on the seashore (22:17), too numerous to count.
Is God interested in of people?
1. God - He is interested in numbers of people.
2. Bible people - God's blessings are beyond our imaginations!
3. Our lives - God does care how many people we share His plan of salvation with.
Genesis 15:6
Was it his in the Lord or his that made him right with God?
To have a right relationship with God one must base it on the heart felt inner confidence that God is who He says He is and He does what He says He will do.
