Overview:

Why should I care?

- Does the feast of FIRSTFRUITS mean anything to me?
- The Historical event was the crossing of the Red Sea.
- Do the Orthodox Jews still celebrate this feast? NO
- When did they stop? After the resurrection

Leviticus 23:9-11

Explanation

- Farmers were to take one stalk of grain to the temple to offer on behalf of the whole harvest.

Understanding the Timing

- Can you see that Yeshua was and is the one stalk of grain offered for the rest of us?

John 20:1-8

What will I do with these facts?

- Will I believe Yeshua/Jesus was the one who died on the cross for me?
- Will I believe Yeshua/Jesus was the one who was raised from the dead for me?
- Is Yeshua/Jesus the savior?
- Is Yeshua/Jesus my savior?

1Corinthians 15:20-22

Conclusions

- *Can you see and understand that the resurrection must be applied to your life?*
- *Have you accepted His resurrection for yourself?*
