3. God's Gracious Grip.

John 3:16 NLT

- Salvation is found, not in self or in them, but "in Him".
- "Trusting-Him-to-do-it is what gets you set right with God, by God. Sheer gift" Romans 4:5 MSG
- Upon salvation we "become children of God" John 1:12.
- He alters our lineage, redefines our spiritual parenthood, and, in doing so, secures our salvation.
