Jeremiah and Us

Jeremiah's Main message was repentance from sin would postpone Judah's coming judgment.

Jeremiah 1:4

1. The Call of Jeremiah.

- **God came to Jeremiah and explained His Loving relationship as Creator.**

- **He values us more highly than we value ourselves.**

2. The Call on our lives.
