The mark of True and False gospels

Galatians

I. The mark of True gospel

Galatians 1:11-12

The true gospel teaches that the source of the gospel is God.

Galatians 2:20

The true gospel knows that life is obtained through death,

II. The False gospels

Galatians 2:21

The false gospels treat Christ's death as meaningless.

Galatians 3:12

The false gospels say people must obey the law in order to be saved.

The True gospel

Galatians 3:14

The true gospel explains that all believers have the Holy Spirit through faith.

Galatians 3:21-22

The true gospel declares that we cannot be saved by keeping laws; the only way of salvation is through faith in Christ, which is available to all.

The False gospels

Galatians 4:10

The false gospels try to find favor with God by observing certain rituals.

Galatians 5:4

The false gospels count on keeping laws to be right with God.

The True gospel

Galatians 3:26-28

The true gospel says that all believers are one in Christ, so there is no basis for discrimination of any kind.

Galatians 5:24-25

The true gospel proclaims that we are free from the grip of sin and that the Holy Spirit's power fills and guides us.
